#### **Dominant:**

V leads back to home

 $V^7$  good for authentic cadences, not half cadences

 $\boldsymbol{V}^{6}$  ,  $\boldsymbol{V}^{7}$  (inv), vii  $^{\boldsymbol{o}_{7}}$  (inv)  $\;\;$  "soft" dominants

cad. <sup>6</sup> V ornamented with nonharmonics

 $V^{6-5}$  [iii] V ornamented with a nonharmonic in major - "Chopin 6th"

### **Predominants:**

ii<sup>(6)</sup>, IV lead to/come right before V

 $ii^7/IV^7$  and inv

IV<sup>6</sup> min: Phrygian cadence

vi first in a chain of predominants; deceptive cadence

## Other passing chords:

passing  $^6$  or  $^6_4$  the passing noodle between  $^5_3$  and  $^6$  bookends of any chord

iii $^6_4$  in major bass  $\hat{1}$ - $\hat{7}$ - $\hat{6}$ - $\hat{5}$ , passes between I and a predom on  $\hat{6}$  V in minor bass  $\hat{1}$ - $\hat{7}$ - $\hat{6}$ - $\hat{5}$ , passes between i and a predom on  $\hat{6}$
